- New Nozzle ordered and should ship in 7-8 weeks
- Memorial Day Parades: FC represented at: Richfield Springs, Schuyler Lake, Hartwick and Cooperstown
- Thank you to those who helped to clean and prep the trucks
- Basement Clean Up: Christmas decorations have been moved to the basement- other items brought up to be stored, donated or discarded
